DETERMINING THE SCOPE

- Decide upon the topic of your paper
- Consult your supervisor on recommended readings
- Choose core key words for search, create a tag cloud for your paper

SEARCHING FOR RESOURCES

- Check the library's resources first, not the Internet
- Find information about printed editions in [the E-catalog of the TSU Research Library](#)
- Compile a list of electronic resources from our [guides](#)
- Check what your predecessors have already written in their [graduate papers](#)
- Compile a list of publications for the last 5 years to determine the most recent trends in your research field



CHECKING

- Check the sources that the author of the publication cites
- Do not use unauthorized content
- Do not refer to Wikipedia, check the resource that Wikipedia refers to
- Refer to the primary resource in printed or electronic form, not to the file from a search engine
- It is important to quote and cite the primary sources
- The quoted text must be enclosed in quotation marks
- [Citations](#) and [reference list](#) should be formatted properly
