Using shelf index in the Research Library of Tomsk State University

Shelf index is the index that indicates the place of storage of a book, magazine or newspaper on a shelf in open access reading rooms of TSU Research Library. It consists of LBC or UDC index and an author mark.

LBC is the Library-Bibliographical Classification according to which the literature on social and humanitarian sciences is systematized in the Research Library. UDC is the Universal Decimal Classification according to which the literature on natural and engineering sciences is systematized. An author mark is a sign that includes the initial letter of author's surname or of the first word of item's title and the number identified by author's table.

You can find shelf index on the bottom of the spine of a book.
