Checklist for referencing an article from a book



- Determine the number of authors
- □ If there is only one author, provide the surname first followed by author's initials separated with a space.
- □ If there are two or three authors, provide the surname and initials of the first author separated with a space. Put a slash / after the article title, give the first author's name and list the others. But this time, the initials separated with a space come before the surname
- □ If there are four authors, none of them is given at the beginning of the entry, they are listed after the article title and a slash /. The order of initials and surnames is the same as mentioned above
- □ If there are more than four authors, none of them is given at the beginning of the entry. Provide the initials and surnames of the first three authors after the book title and a slash /, others are replaced by [et al.]
- Put a double slash mark after the article's author(s) and title element; then provide the details of the document from which the article was taken
- Provide the details of the document from which the article was taken in the correct order: the title of the source (specify, if needed, its type after a colon, e.g., coll. of sci. art., : coll. of sci. conf. materials, etc.), place and year of publication, page range
